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### **PROMINENT SCHOOL ACTIVITIES AND SCHOOL EVENTS**

- ✚ **International Yoga Day Celebration:** On the eve of International Yoga Day a refreshing and energizing camp on Yoga and Pranayam was organized on **21<sup>st</sup> June 2018** for 874 students of Std VI to X in the school premises with a purpose of increasing the level of concentration and learning the better way of meditation. - ✚ **Rakhi Stall :** As a contribution to the society and in collaboration with Sandhya Sanwardhan Santhan, this year also the school arranged a Rakhi stall on the day of PTM on **28<sup>th</sup> July 2018**. The stall exhibited and sold hand made rakhis (worth Rs. 12500/-) which were made by the specially abled children of Sandhya Sanwardhan Santhan thus providing financial assistance to the organization and boosting the morals of these students.
- ✚ **Varsha Sahal :** As a part of pratham sopan of Scout & Guide Programme, the school has organized a Nature Trail for 190 students of Std.
