PATTERN OF EVALUATION FOR THE ACADEMIC SESSION 2023-24 FOR STD.VI - VIII

The students will be assessed in two areas viz. SCHOLASTIC AND CO-SCHOLASTIC.

The term **Scholastic** refers to those aspects which are related to intellect or the brain. It includes assessment of learners in curricular subjects.

The term **Co-Scholastic** refers to those aspects related to hand and heart. These include assessment of psychomotor skills, physical development, life skills, attitude, values, interests and participation in co-curricular activities.

SCHOLASTIC area includes the following subjects -

- Language I (English)
- Language II (Hindi)
- Language III (Sanskrit/Marathi)
- Mathematics
- > Science
- Social Science

Scholastic Area: The assessment structure and examination for classes VI to VIII will comprise of two terms i.e. Term -1 and Term -2:

A. There will be Term – I (Half – yearly written examination) for 80 marks, with revised syllabus covered till announcement of exam dates. Similarly, there will be Term – II (Annual written examination) for 80 marks. However, for Term – II there will be complete revised syllabus of Term – II and revised syllabus coverage of Term – I as given below: -

Class VI - 10% of 1st Term covering significant topics + Entire syllabus of 2nd term.

Class VII - 20% of 1st Term covering significant topics + Entire syllabus of 2nd term.

Class VIII - 30% of 1st Term covering significant topics + Entire syllabus of 2nd term.

The selected portion coverage of Term - I will be announced by the respective subject teacher in Term - II.

B. Periodic Assessment will take place twice a year i.e. before half yearly examination and Annual written examination. The periodic assessment will be on the following aspects.

1. Periodic Test:

The school will conduct two periodic written tests of 20 marks each in all the subjects in the entire academic year and the final score will be brought down to 10.

2. Portfolio/Assignment / Project Submission:

Portfolio / Assignment / Project submission as a part of internal assessment. This would include classwork and other sample work of student work and will carry a weightage of 5 marks towards the final results.

3. Subject Enrichment Activities:

These are subject-specific activities aimed at enhancing the understanding and skills of the students. Art Integrated Activities will be recorded internally by respective subject teachers. It will be assessed out of 5 marks.

- a) Languages: Activities will be conducted to develop effective listening and speaking skills / ALS (Assessment of Listening and Speaking).
- b) Mathematics: Lab activities will be conducted.
- c) Science: Practical work and activities will be conducted.
- d) Social Science: Map and project work will be undertaken.

C. 1) The Scheme of Evaluation for Std. VI and VII in each term is as follows.

2) The Scheme of Evaluation for Std. VIII in each term is as follows.

English, Hindi, Sanskrit/Marathi, Mathematics, Science & Social Science will have one paper of 80 marks each. Compulsory Marathi will have one paper of 50 mark which includes Internal Assessment.

- D. Co Scholastic Activities: For the holistic development of the student, co-curricular activities in the following areas will be carried out by the teachers and graded termwise on a 3-point grading scale. (A= Outstanding, B= Very Good and C= Fair). The aspect of regularity, sincere participation, output and teamwork will be the generic criteria for grading in the following co-scholastic activities.
 - a) Work Education (Computer Science and Photography/Electrical gadgets, Commercial Art).
 - b) Art Education (Visual & Performing Art- Music/ Dance / Tabla / Painting)
 - c) Skill Education Skill Modules (Artificial Intelligence and Financial Literacy) of 12 Hours duration is introduced for classes VI to VIII in addition to Pottery (For class VI), Mask Making (For class VII) and Block Printing (For class VIII).
 - d) Health and Physical Education (Sports / Indigenous sports / Yoga / Scouts & Guides)
- **E. Discipline:** The students will also be assessed for the discipline which will be based on the factors like attendance, sincerity, behavior, values, tidiness, respectfulness for rules and regulations, attitude towards society, nation and others. Grading on Discipline will be done term-wise on a 3 point grading scale

(A=Outstanding, B=Very Good and C=Fair)

Note:

1. It is mandatory for students to secure subject wise minimum D grade and above in all Examinations.

2. Those obtaining less than D grade will not qualify in that subject.

3. Students are advised to refrain from remaining absent as No Retest will be conducted for Periodic Tests.
